MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured at a trial when needed. It is also the exhibitor's responsibility to mark their entry form correctly as to measuring status. Be sure to refer to Agility Rules and Regulations for full details

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

- You need to check the box "YES" on form if your dog will require measuring at this trial. Check "NO" if your dog will not need measured.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate in this trial.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. M.A.D. Agility's equipment is within all specs to AKC requirements. 24" spaced weaves, break-away tires and contacts rubberized.

MEASURING OFFICIALS

Measuring will be available starting at 7:30 am and in between classes as the judge is available. Be sure to have your AKC Registration # with you in case an official rep shows up and can offer official measuring.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Club will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No entry will be refunded after the closing date if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the event committee.

Bitches in season or injured dogs / handlers will be awarded a refund, less \$10.00/dog/day processing fee, with a Veterinary Certificate / Physician's Certificate, Veterinarian's Certificate / Physicians Certificate should be mailed or emailed to the trial secretary prior to trial, or personally presented to trial secretary prior to the commencing of judging on Sunday in order to receive the partial refund.

Trial Secretary will not be held responsible for entries or changes not received at all or not received by any deadline. It is the **exhibitor's responsibility to follow up on any correspondence with the Trial Secretary before any deadline date.** If you do not get an email reply back from the Trial Secretary it most likely means she did not get it and you need to try to contact again using an alternative form of communication.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers will be able to walk each course prior to the start of each class. No dogs will be allowed on course during this time. Handlers with multiple dogs may request to walk with a different height other than the one they are entered in to help accommodate conflicts. It is the handler's responsibility to coordinate conflicts by consulting the judge and ring gate steward. Handlers are not permitted to move themselves on the gate sheets.

Reminder for Mixed Class entries:

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

NITA-NEE KENNEL CLUB TRIAL PROTOCOL

Sportszone

FORMAT:

- This is a one judge trial. Half of the other side of the building will be rented to allow for social distancing.
- Only course builders and club members who are working can crate on the ring side of the building. This is to allow plenty of room for lining up the dogs to allow them to social distance.
- No chairs are permitted to be placed ringside.

Federal, State, and Sportszone COVID-19 policies that are in effect at the time of the trial will be adhered to. The following policies may change to comply with their policies. Your confirmation letter will contain known changes.

MASKS: Masks must be worn over the nose and mouth at all times while in buildings and when near other exhibitors. Please practice social distancing at all times.

Sanitation: Wash hands frequently and thoroughly. Bring hand sanitizer to use at your crating area.

Food: Food is available for purchase. You may briefly remove your mask to eat, but must social distance while eating. Please use the picnic tables or eat in your vehicles. No shared food such as potlucks or MACH cakes permitted. Absolutely no food permitted on the turf.

Crating: Crating is permitted on the turf. Allow 6 feet between crates for unrelated parties.

Course Maps: Course maps will be posted so that you can take a picture with your phone or other device. Paper maps will not be distributed.

Course Builders: A limited number of people are selected to course build and we do not want to have extra people at this time. We are grateful that we always have a lot of help but due to COVID will ask for help as needed. All course builders must sanitize their hands before and after setting up the course, or wear

disposable gloves. Sanitizer and gloves are provided at the scoring table.

Ring Crew: Ring crew must sanitize their hands before and after entering the ring, or wear disposable gloves. Sanitizer and gloves are provided at the scoring table.

Check-in: A gate steward will be available during walk-throughs to check-in exhibitors. If you wish to check-in earlier, please use your own pen. Always maintain a 6-foot distance from other exhibitors. We recommend taking a picture of the running order with your phone as reference.

Entering and Exiting Ring: Stay at least 6 feet away from the team before and after you while waiting to go into the ring.

Results: Results will be posted. Please practice social distancing when checking scores.

Ribbons: Ribbons are not self-service. We will make every effort to have ribbons with stickers available as quickly as possible.

NOTE: Please study these rules carefully before you enter our trial to make sure you understand the requirements and are willing to abide by them. To ensure your understanding and commitment to follow our requirements, please sign the last page of this document and return it with your entry.

A valid entry requires a signed NNKC COVID19 Protocol Pledge.

NITA-NEE KENNEL CLUB COVID19 PROTOCOL PLEDGE

I pledge to promote my own safety as well as that of the other exhibitors, judges and volunteers at by agreeing to these requirements:

I have read, understand, and agree to the following rules and the procedures set forth above. I am responsible for any guest that accompanies me to also follow protocol.

- If I become exposed to the virus or feel ill prior to the closing date, I will contact the trial secretary who will refund my entry at 100% by pulling my entry and shredding the check.
- Should I become ill at the trial I will notify the Trial Chair and then I will leave. The club will refund me for any uncompleted runs less the \$10 / run / day service fee.
- To the best of my knowledge, I do not have Covid-19, I have not been exposed to it within the last two weeks, and I have had no symptoms (fever, cough, etc.) for 14 days.
- If I become ill at the trial, I will notify the Trial Chair and then I will leave and my remaining entry for the weekend will be refunded.
- I agree to wear a mask over my nose and mouth in the buildings, and when I am near other exhibitors.
- I agree to practice social distancing and frequent hand washing/sanitizing.
- I understand that if I am not in compliance with these guidelines, and I refuse to comply, I will be asked to leave the trial and entry fees will be forfeited.
- I am entering this trial at my own volition and am responsible for my own health. The American Kennel Club, the Nita-Nee Kennel Club, and the Sportszone are in no way liable for any present or future COVID-19 infection incurred at any time by any person in attendance or not in attendance, before, during, or after this event.
- I understand that a valid entry requires my signature verifying my agreement with this document.

Accurate information is important so that we can notify you if someone at the trial tests positive for COVID-19 or other contagious disease after the trial.

FEO and Fix and Go On have been approved by the AKC Board of Directors to remain a permanent part of the AKC Agility program.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. **Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.**
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. **Day of show level changes are not allowed.**
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

ADDITIONAL EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. **WATERPROOF TARPS MUST BE USED UNDER ALL CRATING.**
 - **No Food / Drink except Water allowed on sprint turf**
 - **Crate-aggressive dogs are not to be situated near any of the rings or busy walkways. This includes outside in vehicles as well.**
2. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMITTED during trial hours.**
3. **All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump.**
4. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
5. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AKC agility rules and regulations and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
6. Telegraph, telephone, email, AKC online entries, fax, and unsigned entries will not be accepted.
7. All calls to the Trial Secretary must be before 1 PM Mon – Fri or 10am-9pm Sat / Sun.
8. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules printed on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT acceptable and will be returned!
9. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The club treasurer will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.
10. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. Entry fees do not have to be refunded in event of such error.
11. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at the show site. Failure to do so will result in dismissal.
12. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
13. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up the judging schedule. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the agility ring when they are called to be judged.
14. It is expressly understood that every dog and child at this trial are in the care, custody and control of its owner, handler, or parent during the entire time the dog or child is on the trial premises. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or child create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
15. Neither the club nor the facility are responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause.
16. Declination of Entries: The named Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
17. Trial Secretary is not responsible for incorrect information on any entry. Trial Secretary is not responsible for entries or emails not received on time or not received at all.
18. Treasurer may opt to mail refunds after the trial or hand out at the trial.

DAY TO DAY MOVE UPS

Per American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the Owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title.

Move ups are due in writing by Monday, 5/31/2021 at 6 pm.

INSTRUCTIONS: Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
